THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION,

Mindful of the Constitution;

Mindful of Law n° 005 of 16th April 2001 bearing on the orientation of Higher Education;

Mindful of Decree n° 93/026 of 19th January 1993 to create Universities;

Mindful of Decree n° 93/027 of 19th January 1993 fixing common dispositions in State Universities, modified and supplemented by Decree n° 2005/342 of 10th September 2005;

Mindful of Decree n° 2005/342 of 10th September 2005 amending and supplementing certain dispositions of the Decree n° 93/027 of 19th January 1993 laying down common dispositions to universities;

Mindful of Decree n° 2005/383 of 17th October 2005 establishing the financial regime applicable to universities;

Mindful of Decree n° 2012/433 of 1st October 2012 to organize the Ministry of Higher Education;

Mindful of Decree n° 2018/190 of 2nd March 2018 to complete certain dispositions of decree n° 2011/408 of December 9th, 2011 to organize the Government;

Mindful of Decree n° 2018/191 of 2nd March 2018 forming the Government;

Mindful of Decree n° 2019/002 of 4th January 2019 to Reshuffle the Government;

Mindful of Decree n° 2022/003 of 5th January 2022 to create Universities;

Mindful of Decree n° 2022/202 of 3th June 2022 appointing the chairmen of the boards of directors of certain state universities;

Mindful of Decree n° 2022/203 of 3th June 2022 appointing Vice Chancellors of certain state universities;

Mindful of Decree n° 2022/008 of 6th January 2022, to organize the University of Bertoua;

Mindful of Decree n° 2023/303 of 04th July 2023 appointing Managers of certain state universities;

Mindful of Decision n° 18230069/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 11th April 2023 fixing the calendar of the competitive entrance examination into Schools and Faculties of State Universities for the 2023-2024 academic year;

HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: (1) A competitive written examination of **two hundred (200) students** for admission into the **1st year** of the training for Masters in Engineering degree in five (05) years at the Higher School of Urban Planning and Tourism Sciences of the University of Bertoua in Abong Mbang for the 2023-2024 academic year at the following centers: **Abong-Mbang, Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buéa, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundéré and Yaoundé.**

(2) Students admitted to the engineering program at the end of their second year will have to choose between the following fields of study: (i) Restructuring and urban regeneration, (ii) Urban mobility and planning, (iii) Spatial planning and land registry, (iv) Development of tourist sites, (v) Urban engineering and (vi) Urban sanitation.

Article 2: The competitive entrance examination is organized in a single session for Cameroonians of both sexes and to foreign candidates of at most 29 years of age as of 1st January of the year of writing the competitive examination.

Article 3 : This concerns :

- students in Science and Industrial Technology final year classes, series C, D, E, F, IT, BT, classes in *Upper Sixth* sciences (pure mathematics, Physics, and Applied mathematics, or Chemistry) and who have obtained their GCE-O/L in at least four papers, (except « Religious Knowledge) » ;
- holders of the 'Baccalauréat' in the above-mentioned series or the GCE-A/L;
- holders of any other diploma recognised as equivalent or exempt by the Minister for Higher Education.

Article 4: Candidates who register pending one of the certificates mentioned above will be declared to have passed only after successfully obtaining the certificate during the 2023 session of the examination. In case the candidate succeeds in the competitive examination, the original of this Certificate or the Success Testimonial must be presented to ESSUT during registration.

Article 5: The candidates application files must comprise all the following documents:

- a- A duly filled application form obtainable from ESSUT, the Regional Delegations of Ministry of Secondary Education or from the website of the Institution's Competitive examination: <http://www.univ-bertoua.cm>;
- b- A certified photocopy of candidates National Identity card or deposit receipt of the ID card or the student's identity card dated not more than three months old;
- c- A certified photocopy of birth certificate, dated not more than three (03) months from date of establishment;
- d- Transcripts of the GCE O/L and the GCE A/L, as case may be;
- e- A certified photocopy of transcripts results of the GCE O/L and the GCE A/L or other certificates recognised as equivalents by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education or an Attestation of Success as case the may be;
- f- A medical certificate issued by a medical doctor working with the Public Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically apt to pursue higher education studies;
- g- An envelope (A4 format) bearing postal stamps of 1500 francs CFA with candidates address;
- h- A receipt for payment of the fee entitling you to take part in the competition;
- i- Four (04) passport size (4x4) photographs.

Article 6: A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) CFA as registration fees delivered by Express Union SA after presentation of your confirmation letter of online registration. These fees, which are non-refundable, are intended to cover the expenses generated by the organisation of the competition. No other form of payment shall be accepted.

Article 7: Application files can be submitted at the Direction of ESSUT, or at the 10 (ten) Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education, right up till **Friday 22th September 2023 at 5 pm**. However, nationals of CEMAC countries will be able to submit their application files to the diplomatic representations of Cameroon in their respective countries.

Article 8: The written tests will take place on **Wednesday 27th September 2023** at the following locations: Abong Mbang (Bilingual High School), Bafoussam (IUT-FOTSO Victor of Bandjoun),

Bamenda (Delegation of Secondary Education, Up Station), Bertoua (Scientific High School), Douala (Deido High School), Ebolowa (ENSET), Garoua (Classical and Modern High School), Maroua (College of Hope), Ngaoundéré (Classical and Modern High School) and Yaoundé (Ngoa Ekelé Commercial Technical High School).

Article 9: (1) The competition is made up of three (03) tests, 75% of which are written, and a report on the candidate's work, 25% of which is written.

(2) The application mark is determined on the basis of the candidate's age and secondary academic performance.

Article 10: (1) The competition syllabus is that of the *Première and Terminale* classes of the above-mentioned series for candidates from the French-speaking sub-system and that of the *lower and Upper Sixth*. Scientific series for candidates from the English-speaking sub-system.

(2) The running order of the tests is as follows:

SUBJECT /EPREUVE	TIME /DUREE
PHYSICS/PHYSIQUES	08H – 10H
MATHEMATICS/MATHEMATIQUES	11H – 13H
ENGLISH/FRANÇAIS	14H – 15H

Article 11: At the end of its deliberations, the jury will draw up a list, by speciality and in alphabetical order of the candidates proposed for final admission, which will be published by the Minister of State, Minister for Higher Education.

Article 10: The composition of the jury mentioned in the above articles is specified by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

Article 11: The Rector of the University of Bertoua, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the Higher School of Urban Planning and Tourism Sciences of Abong Mbang, each in his own sphere are responsible, for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
